

ORDINANCE NO. 2003 - 05

TOWN OF MOORES HILL, INDIANA

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING TRUCK ROUTES IN  
THE TOWN OF MOORES HILL

WHEREAS, the Town Council ("Council") of the Town of Moores Hill, Indiana, ("Town") has determined that it is necessary to designate certain streets in said Town as "truck routes" in order to prevent damage to local streets that are not designed to accommodate regular use by vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of ~~five (5)~~ <sup>TEN (10)</sup> tons or more; and

WHEREAS, having inventoried the streets of said Town to determine structural capacity, width, and location said Council has determined that three such streets have the capability to sustain regular use by vehicles weighing in excess of ~~five (5)~~ <sup>TEN (10)</sup> tons gross vehicle weight and are, therefore, designated as Truck Routes in the Town of Moores Hill, as follows: (1) State Road 350; (2) Manchester Street between State Road 350 and Main Street; and (3) Main Street between ~~Manchester Street~~ <sup>ADAMS</sup> and State Road 350 at the east end of the Town limits.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Moores Hill, Indiana, that:

1. The following named streets in the Town of Moores Hill are hereby designated as Truck Routes in the Town of Moores Hill in that vehicles weighing in excess of ~~five (5)~~ <sup>TEN (10) TONS</sup> tons gross vehicle weight shall be permitted to use said streets without restriction:

- A. State Road 350;
- B. Manchester Street between State Road 350 and ~~Main Street~~ <sup>College St</sup>; and
- C. Main Street between Adams Street and State Road 350 at the east end of the Town limits.

2. All other streets within the corporate limits of the Town of Moores Hill are hereby designated as Local Streets and vehicles using said Local Streets shall be limited to vehicles weighing less than five (5) tons gross vehicle weight.

3. Any person found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25) per violation. Each day that a violation continues shall be a new violation.

4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council, and filing and publication as required by law.

5. All other ordinances or regulations in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
